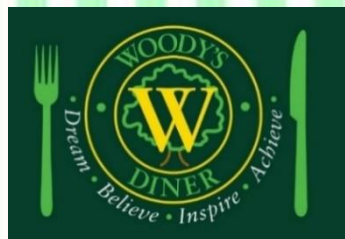

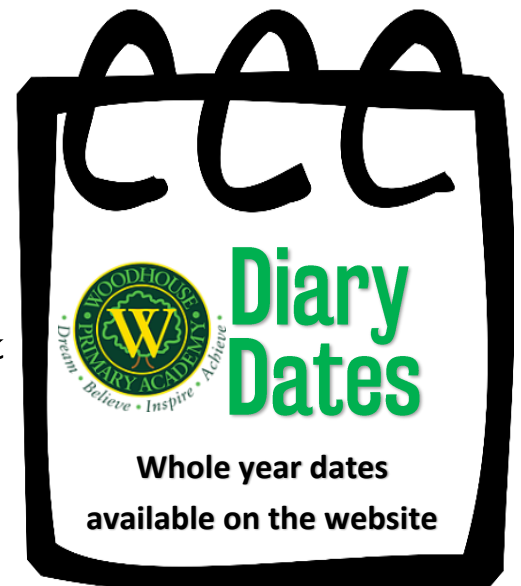

We are also able to access support for a wide range of household items such as white goods, beds, bedding etc.

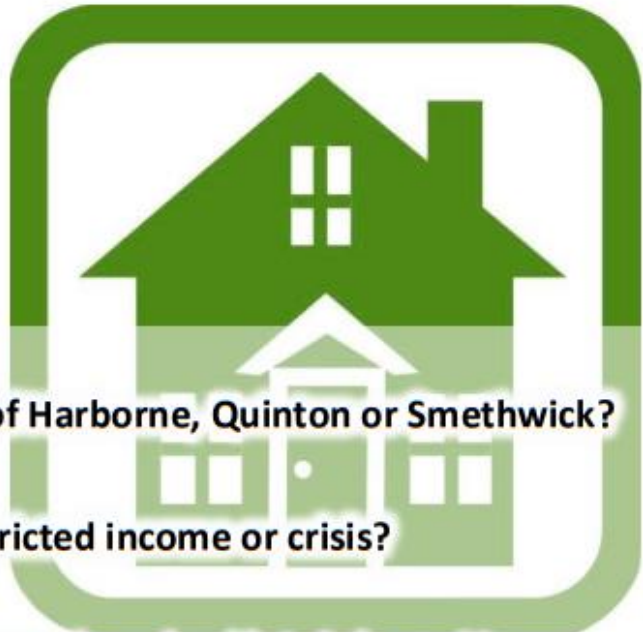

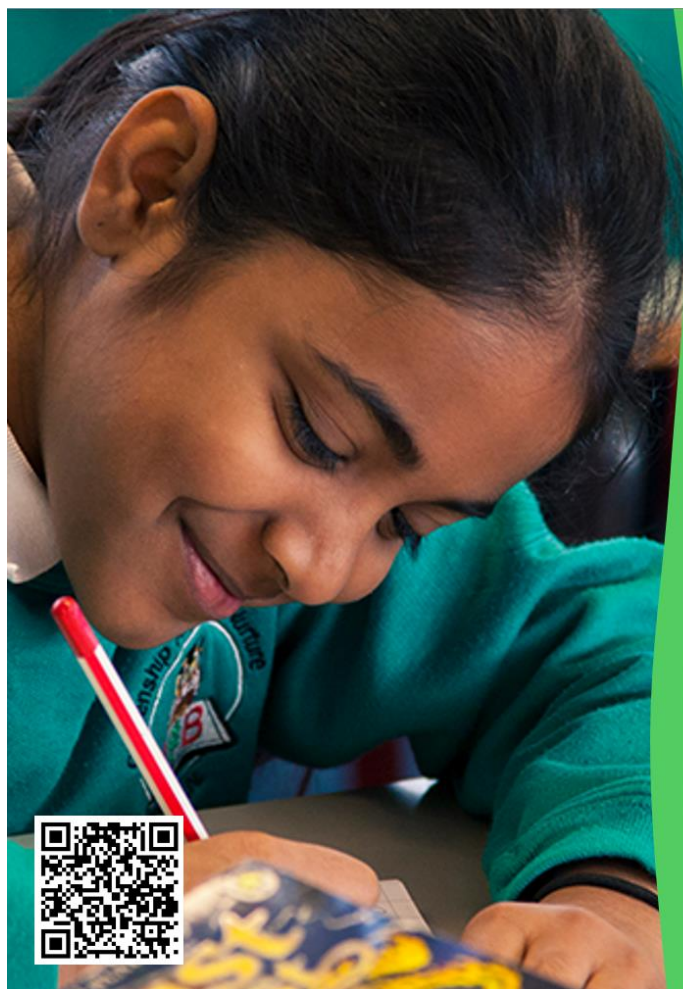
Train to teach and unlock your career
