## Theme Overview

## Knowledge Base

- To be able to use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to: key physical features, including beach, cliff, coast, sea, ocean, season and weather key human features, including town, port, harbour and shop.
- To be able to use aerial photographs to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features; devise a simple map; and use and construct basic symbols in a key.
- To be able to discuss changes within living memory. Where appropriate, these should be used to reveal aspects of change in national life.

- To identify key land features of the coastal town: Weston Super Mare
- To discuss key activities which can be done at the seaside past and present.
- To be able to create a land map using symbols
- To reflect upon the changes of their local history
