RE: Ofsted Inspection of Woodhouse Primary Academy 4th - 5th March, 2025

Dear parents and carers,

I am delighted to be able to officially share the outcome of our recent Ofsted inspection with you all. As you will know, our inspection took place on Tuesday 4th and Wednesday 5th March and was carried out by Mr Mark Sims, Ofsted Inspector.

The official outcome of the inspection is that: ***"Woodhouse Primary Academy has taken effective action to maintain the standards identified at the previous inspection."***

At our December 2019 Ofsted inspection, the school was again graded as Good overall, also sustaining the outstanding ratings in both "behaviour and attitudes" and "personal development" from our full graded Ofsted inspection in July 2015. Since September 2024, Ofsted no longer uses single word judgements for schools. Our Inspector, Mark Sims also assessed that there were some areas of significant improvement from the previous inspection.

We are delighted that the inspector recognised the many things that we do well at Woodhouse. He commented in our verbal feedback on the strengths he saw in many of the areas of our work as a school.

These included:

- Reading, Early Reading and Phonics teaching.
- Our Inclusive ethos. There is a significant strength in support for all children, but especially those with additional needs.
- Maths and Early Maths teaching.
- Early Years provision.
- Positive behaviour and attitudes of the children.
- Strong personal development of children at Woodhouse.

As a team, we are proud of the recognition that this positive inspection outcome gives to Woodhouse Primary Academy. This is testament to the care, dedication and commitment of our staff, the support of our parents and carers, and of course, a celebration of our wonderful children.

There are always things we can do better as a school. Our report also identified that there are two areas for development for us to work on following the inspection. You can see these in full within the report. We have been developing our assessment to check children's learning across the wider curriculum over the past school year. There is already an action plan which we are working through this area of our school

development plan and the inspector noted that these plans show high potential. As a school, we also put a lot of effort into developing the children as global citizens who care about their community. It is testament to the hard work and commitment of all of our staff team, our successful partnership with parents and the local community and of course the daily hard work of the brilliant children of Woodhouse. Together, we have much to be proud of.
