# School Admissions

If you currently have a child in Year 6 or of Nursery age then this is the time of year you need to be applying for the next phase of their education.

Year 6 will be moving to secondary school in September 2026 and Nursery age children will be starting Reception.

For both of these, you need to apply online to the local authority where you live.

You can apply to any school, even those outside of your local authority. For example, if you live in Quinton, which falls under the Birmingham LA, you can still apply to Leasowes High School, which falls under the Dudley LA.

The deadlines to get applications in on time are as follows:

Year 6 moving to Secondary school: **31<sup>st</sup> October at 23:59**  
**[Now closed – late applications can still be made]**

Nursery moving to Reception: **15<sup>th</sup> January 2026 at 23:59**

Any applications after these dates will be classes as late and won't be processed until after the on-time applications. This may result in your first choice school not being available.

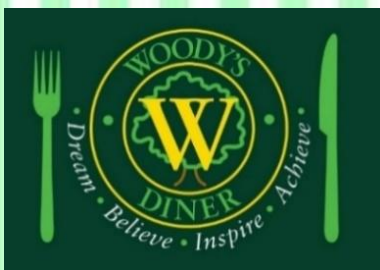

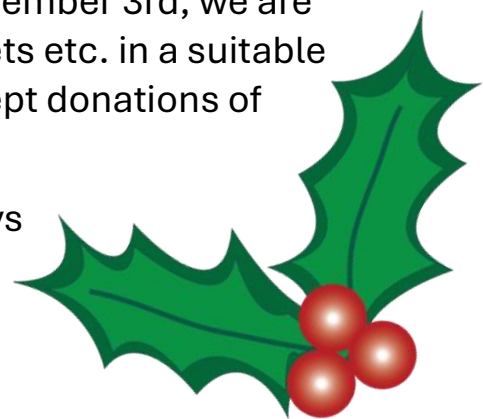
Closer to the date we will also be having non-uniform days where donations can be made.
