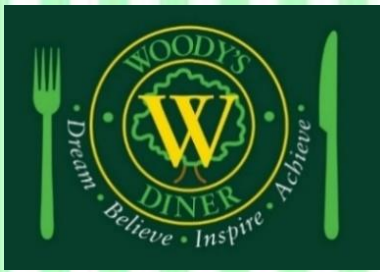

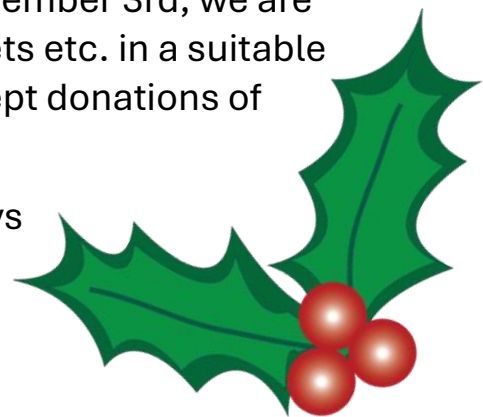
Closer to the date we will also be having non-uniform days where donations can be made.
