Our Year 6 leavers hoodies are now available to order from Cicada Sports.

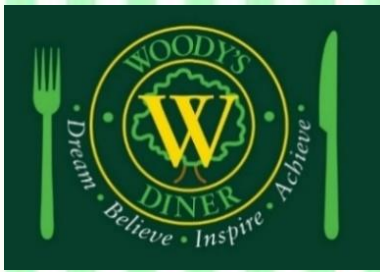
The Hoodie comes with the school logo on the front and the back as in the photo. This costs £21.95 OR £23.45 with Initials or name on the front.
